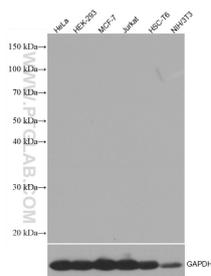

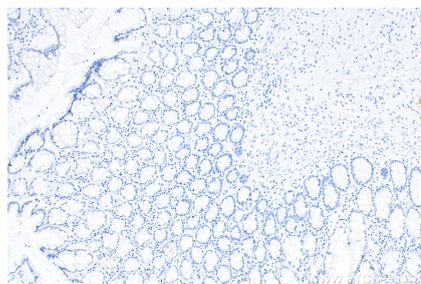

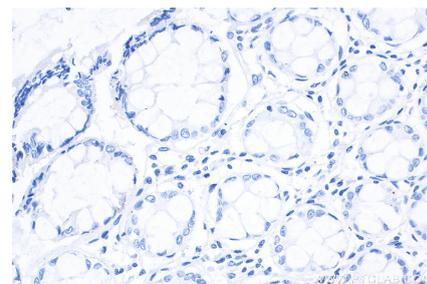
Selected Validation Data



Various lysates (50 ug/lane) were subjected to SDS PAGE followed by western blot with 66360-3-Ig (Mouse IgG2b isotype control antibody) at dilution of 1:1000 incubated at room temperature for 1.5 hours. This data was developed using the same antibody clone with 66360-3-PBS in a different storage buffer formulation.



Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffin-embedded human colon tissue slide using 66360-3-Ig (Mouse IgG2b isotype control antibody) at dilution of 1:2000 (under 10x lens). Heat mediated antigen retrieval with Tris-EDTA buffer (pH 9.0). This data was developed using the same antibody clone with 66360-3-PBS in a different storage buffer formulation.
